







Keeping sight of Motives



- Used effectively?



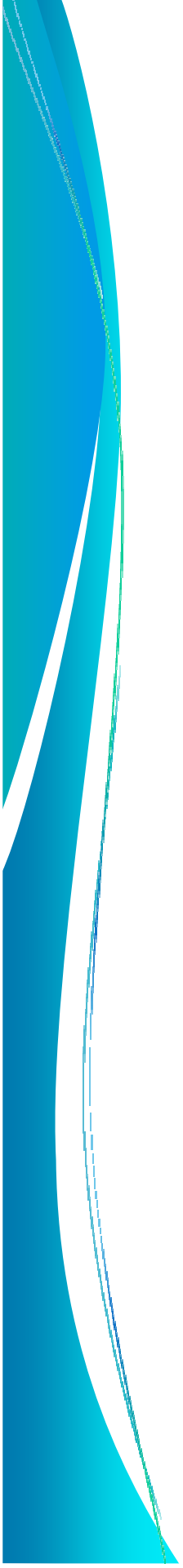
RANTS
